It also adjusts its orientation and layout automatically and allows you to seamlessly switch between multiple languages. iPad comes with the powerful note-taking app, Notes, which syncs through iTunes and integrates seamlessly with MobileMe.

Stylize your notes.

You can take notes and draw figures freehand on iPad, just as you would with paper and pen. With your finger or stylus (sold separately), apps like Penultimate and Notes Plus give you the freedom to write and draw the old-fashioned way, only better. Specify pen and paper color, line thickness, transparency, and font type and size. When you're finished taking notes, organize them in folders or instantly share them with colleagues via email or iTunes file sharing.

Tap to record and instantly see your transcripts displayed. It's a great way to document meetings, set reminders, and create email or text messages.
