Keynote

Open, edit, and present Keynote and PowerPoint presentations on iPad. Use templates, transitions, and graphics to create stunning presentations.

The Keynote app lets you view and edit Keynote '09 and PowerPoint files on your iPad. And the presentations you create in Keynote on iPad can be exported as Keynote '09, PowerPoint, or PDF files. Whether you use a Mac or PC, you always have the flexibility to work with the files you need, right from your iPad.

When you're ready to present, simply tap to begin and swipe to move forward or backward through your slides. The Multi-Touch iPad display transforms your finger gestures into lifelike actions, so presenting is easy and intuitive.

But don't keep iPad to yourself. Pass it to your customer or colleague and let them swipe, tap, and pinch through your presentation. The immersive experience will lend itself to a memorable customer engagement.

Captivate a crowd.

It's never been easier to capture the attention of a crowd with iPad. For larger audiences, connect iPad to an external display, projector, or HDTV using the Apple Digital AV Adapter or Apple VGA Adapter (sold separately). With Keynote, your iPad becomes the presenter display, allowing you to view your current slide, next slide, and speaker notes while your presentation appears on the large screen.

With iPad 2, video mirroring is built in, allowing you to show any app, web page, presentation, video, movie, or photo on another screen. Everyone sees what's on your iPad, even when you rotate from portrait to landscape, or pinch to zoom in and out. Show a product training video in a classroom, give a boardroom presentation with an HD projector, or display a gallery of images from your latest trade show in an amphitheater—the possibilities to make a splash with iPad are endless.

For the original iPad, you can select an app with VGA output capabilities to mirror your presentation on another screen. In addition to Keynote for displaying presentations, you can use other apps to display PDF files, Microsoft Office documents, and videos:

With apps like Conference Pad, you can share PDF presentations from your iPad to up to 15 iOS devices—iPad, iPhone, or iPod touch—simultaneously over Bluetooth® or Wi-Fi. Your iPad acts as the controlling device. When you change pages, pinch to zoom, or tap and hold to activate the laser pointer, all other devices will instantly do the same.

Conference Pad lets you review and share plans, product briefs, or other multipage documents without having to print out numerous pages. It's the perfect app to add a new dimension and focus to your group presentation while accommodating your mobile colleagues and customers.
